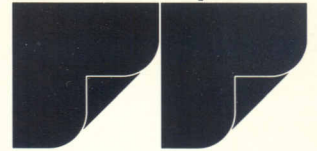

Solitaire Gloss has an extremely smooth surface compared to other #1 coated papers. The result is sharper definition in four-color process, more uniform solids and tints, and a printed gloss that rivals that of much costlier papers.

On rougher sheets, ink dots land on the sides of countless microscopic hills and valleys. The result is dots that point every which way. So, images don't achieve the shine and uniformity they do on Solitaire.

Solitaire's smooth finish yields a high printed gloss because most every dot points at you, the viewer. And the paper's excellent ink holdout assures that those

dots stay on the surface and don't lose their shape.

To see what we mean about high printed gloss, look at our varnish demonstration on the next spread. The varnish is almost redundant.

When visuals need to be big,
bold and sharp, Solitaire Gloss is
a natural choice. Metal shines.
Jewelry glistens. Sharp edges are
excellently defined. Your simple
jobs become better-looking.

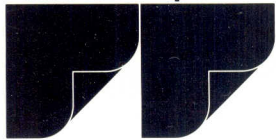
